Areas of growth

Continue to Grow Technical Skills

Oscar has been actively expanding his technical skill set, he's recently added Airflow to his technical toolbox and has been expanding his understanding of DBT. He should continue to lean into those technologies and grow his mastery of both of them as they will be a part of our core infrastructure moving forward. Oscar should also continue to grow his mastery of Python and programming best practices.

Embrace Team Based Approach

For much of his tenure, Oscar has been a one man BI powerhouse. He never shies away from more work thrown his way and he's always quick to own the projects sent his direction. These are admirable traits that have served him well and made him the company's go-to-guy for all things data. The problem with a one man show is that it's difficult to scale, creates a bottleneck to our flow, and creates isolation and specialization of knowledge within the team. This is why we've been transforming the Tech Department to one that follows a more Team-based approach. Oscar is now on a team of competent Data Engineers and Data Analysts, he should lean into the Team-based approach so he can continue to expand his impact.

Some areas to focus on:

- Plan and tackle work as a team
- Use Mob programming to unblock each other, craft the best solutions, and disseminate knowledge
- Work in small batches and leverage code reviews for speedy feedback
- Optimize for fast delivery and leverage the larger team for testing and validation
- Spread investigations and ad-hoc requests across the team
- Delegate purely technical tasks to the data engineers so the analysts can focus on dataset delivery and visualization
- Help the team optimize our tooling and processes for the team based approach

Expand Understanding of Products and Grow Impact of our Data Analysis

To date, a lot of the metrics and data analysis needs have been focused on core business functions like Cost Reporting, Invoicing, Fraud Prevention and Campaign Delivery. Oscar has a good understanding of these core models and is well versed in the Tune and MMP data that powers them. As we continue to lay down a stronger technical foundation, the focus of our analysis should move beyond the core business functions and help drive change within the business and within our products to drive greater value. As we progress, our Data/BI Analysts should be connecting more directly with the products and more focused on data modeling and data exploration to help empower our product teams and move our products forward.
